## DD REFERENCE GUIDE

### EXPLANATION OF SYMBOLS

#### Symbol Symbols Indicating Change

- N** New C.O. code not previously listed. Represents either establishment of a new C.O. code; a new code where an existing code is being changed due to conversion to 7D numbering; change in preassigned code of a location not 7D; or a C.O. code being protected in another NPA. This symbol is used in Section 3.1 to indicate a listing for a new Business Office and also in Section 4.1 to indicate a listing for a new Revenue Accounting Office.
- D** Discontinued C.O. code. Represents generally a change in code coincident with conversion to 7D numbering. May also result from a change in a preassigned code where required prior to conversion to 7D, also discontinuing a Business Office Code or Revenue Accounting Office Code.
- p** Indicates change in C.O. code column, e.g., completed conversion to ANC.
- y** City name is being changed, e.g., change from rate center name to principal locality served by C.O. code.
- m** Business Office address or telephone number changed.
- o** Operator code or Check Coin Series changed.
- c** V coordinate or H coordinate, or both, changed.
- a** Revenue Accounting Office code changed.
- b** Accounting Toll Center code changed.
- e** Revenue Accounting Office address, toll information or Telephone Number changed. The symbol is shown on the line in which the information changed.
- t** Time Zone and/or Daylight Saving Time change.
- Note: The above symbols will remain until the page is reissued for other changes.

#### Other Symbols

- O.L.** Where shown in lieu of V-H coordinates indicates that Other Line rates apply. Rate information may be obtained by reference to Operating Rate and Route Guide.
- (FX)** Where shown in City column indicates that C.O. code serves exclusively (on a foreign exchange basis) customers located in the city name shown. It is an indication that the V-H coordinates are those of the rate center from which service is purchased and not those of the rate center shown in the City column.
- T** Shown in Business Office Code column to indicate that C.O. code furnishes only Time service.
- W** Shown in Business Office Code column to indicate that C.O. code furnishes only Weather service.
- O** Shown in Business Office Code column to indicate that C.O. code furnishes only Company Official service.
- B** Shown in Business Office Code column to indicate that the C.O. code or line number block furnishes only Bellboy service.
- G** Shown in Business Office Code column to indicate that C.O. code furnishes only Government Switched service.
- P** Shown in Business Office Code column to indicate that the C.O. code has been established for Plant test purposes.
- φ** Shown in Actg. T.C. Code column to indicate that an Accounting Toll Center Code has been assigned to a Toll Point for Division of Revenue purposes.
- \*** Shown in the Yellow Page section to indicate "For TWX-Write Only."

- \* Shown in White and Pink Page section for Zone Cities to indicate City-wide V-H coordinates apply over 40 miles where applicable and exception time zones.
- † Shown in C.O. Code Name column to indicate 7D, but not customer dialable.
- # Shown in C.O. Name column to indicate IDDD capabilities.

Other Symbols — Used on Printed Guide Sheets Only (Not on TAW 181-B)

- ▲ Shown in lieu of V-H coordinates to indicate that Overseas Rates apply. Consult Operating Rate and Route Guide.
- ◆ Shown in the C.O. code name column to indicate full ANC numbering.

## DD REFERENCE GUIDE

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR REPORTING CHANGES, ADDITIONS AND DELETION

GENERAL

The DD Reference Guide is published by the Long Lines Traffic Routing Engineer at Kansas City. It lists all central office codes, both Bell and Independent. Each Bell Company is responsible for reporting information for the Independent Company C.O. codes in its territory, as well as its own (Bell). Where an Independent Company's territory involves more than one Bell Company, the Bell Companies involved should make local arrangements as to which company will report.

Revised pages are issued monthly to all holders of the Guide. New and changed information is included in revised pages issued as of the fifteenth of the month prior to the month in which the addition or change is effective. Accordingly, information must reach Long Lines by the first of the third month prior to the month in which it is effective, e.g., May 1 for July 15 revised pages to include changes through the first routing date in August. This schedule is consistent with the reporting of new or changed information for the Operating Rate and Route Guide. Changes pertaining to "Revenue Accounting Office Addresses," Section 4.1 must be reported by the first of the month prior to the month in which it is issued, e.g., May 1 for a June 15 issue to include changes through July 1st.

The Bell Company Accounting Department is responsible for forwarding information to Long Lines. Since mechanized toll billing is dependent on information in the Guide, it is necessary that this information be accurate and complete. Accordingly, Accounting should make specific arrangements with Traffic and Commercial and, where appropriate, the Independent Relations Group, to insure that all new and discontinued C.O. codes and all other changes affecting information in the Guide, be reported to Accounting in time to meet the reporting schedule.

In reporting information to Accounting, the other departments should use Form TAW 181-B or other locally designed forms.

Traffic initiates the form monthly, listing all C.O. code additions, deletions, or changes (including cases where only the toll center of a code is changed) which are planned for the fourth succeeding month, i.e., an August change should be on the form which Traffic initiates in April. Traffic should furnish the "Type of Entry," "Effective Date," "C.O. code" "C.O. code name" (or ANC) including a + if the 7D number is not customer dialable, "Check Coin," "Operator Code," and "C.T.I. Telephone Number." The name of the toll center should be shown for all new C.O. codes to aid Accounting in assigning the accounting toll center code. Codes used for special billing numbers, Bellboy, and Plant Test should be similarly reported.

The form is then forwarded to Commercial for entry of "V-H" coordinates, Time Zone Code, Daylight Saving indicator, the name (not abbreviated) of the "City" to be shown as "place called" on toll statements, and the "Business Office Code." (See Section 1.4 for selection of name for City column). Any changes in "Business Office Codes," "Addresses" and "Telephone Numbers" are also to be listed on the form by Commercial.

The form is then forwarded to Accounting where the "RAO" code, "Actg. T.C." code, "RAO Address," "Toll Info." telephone number and "CMDS Cutover" date are entered. Accounting is also responsible for arranging the information in the format provided in the instructions if it is not already in the proper format. Changes to instructions and notations contained in Section 4.1, "Revenue Accounting Office Addresses," and assignments of new RAO codes and changes in existing RAO codes must be obtained by contacting the Comptrollers Department, American Tel. and Tel. Co., 195 Broadway, New York, New York 10007. (Area Code 212 393-3039.) CMDS cutover dates may be obtained from schedules developed within your company.

The reports may be prepared at the Operating Area or Company Staff Level, at the option of the ~~Company~~. In any event, all activity for a given NPA should be in a single report. The information reported by each of the departments must cover Independent Company as well as Bell C.O. Codes. It is important that a report be initiated each month by Traffic even though there is no activity to report for the NPA. In this case Traffic should enter "Nothing to Report" and forward the form to Commercial. If Commercial likewise has no information to report, this fact should be noted on the form. Accounting should forward a completed monthly report to Long Lines for each NPA, noting "Nothing to Report," when appropriate. Before releasing the report, Accounting will show name of person preparing report, telephone number and date.

An initial supply of Form TAW 181-B has been furnished by Long Lines to each Company's Accounting Staff. Additional requirements may be obtained by letter to the above address.

### INFORMATION TO BE REPORTED ON FORM TAW 181-B (See Illustrative Examples in Section 1.6)

The following additions, deletions and changes should be reported on Form TAW 181-B prepared for each NPA.

#### 1. Number Conversion

Changes resulting from the conversion of the numbering arrangement of a location, e.g., 4D to 7D, 2-5 to ANC, etc. (See Examples 1 and 2.) If not customer dialable add the heavy plus (+) symbol. (See Example 38.)

When 7D, 2L+, or C.O. Name changes from not customer dialable to customer dialable show the deletion of the heavy plus (+) symbol. (See Example 39.)

#### 2. C.O. Code Addition (Excluding Special Services)

Addition of new 7D C.O. codes. (See Examples 3 and 6.)

Additions of new locations not on a 7D numbering basis: in reporting such a location, the "C.O. code," for Mark Sense purposes, should preferably be the future central office code. In the event the future C.O. code is temporarily in use to identify another rate center, or if the ultimate code has not been designated, then another non-conflicting NNX code should be agreed upon by the Traffic planning and routing people and reported. (See Example 4.)

In the event a NNX type code, other than the future C.O. code, is used as a routing code to reach a dial office not yet on a 7D basis, the routing code should be included in the Guide since DDD customers may reach such points. Furthermore, it would be preferable to use the routing code as the Mark Sense Code. Where more than one routing code is used to reach a multi-office city, all such codes should be reported.

For example, let us assume that Anytown, Anystate, is reached with an arbitrary routing code of 48+ and has five digit numbers starting with the digit five through nine. In this example, the Codes 485 through 489 would be reported in the Guide. (Of course, NNX type routing codes would not be used where it would allow DDD customers to reach toll center or tributary operators.) (See Example 5.)

#### 3. Discontinuance of a Central Office Code
